### **Full and part-time admission to a school Reception Year and entry to a Nursery Class**

This letter is intended to remind you about the requirements in relation to providing education for early years and reception aged children.

#### **Reception Class entry**

Children are entitled to a full-time place in the Reception Year from the beginning of the Autumn term following their fourth birthday. The law makes it clear that, if parents or carers should choose to, they may defer full-time entry until later in the year – but it cannot be any later than the term after the child's fifth birthday (statutory school age).

Parents and carers are entitled to receive full-time education for their child from the start of the term if that is their wish. Schools may only make alternative arrangements with the full agreement of each parent or carer concerned and if parents or carers wish, schools must agree to make the place available full-time from the start of the term.

#### **Nursery Class entry**

Parents and carers are entitled to access the early education entitlement they have agreed to take with you from the beginning of the term for a child joining a school nursery class. An induction period at a school nursery can mean that a child is unable to access the nursery provision they have been offered at the school, from the first day of term. This can cause problems for parents and carers who rely on this provision as part of their childcare arrangements because they are working or training. Any induction arrangements therefore need to be made with the full agreement and understanding of the parents and carers concerned. If parents and carers wish their child to take up the sessions they have been offered and accepted from the first day of term, then the school must agree to this.
