Egress Switch

You will have noticed that in recent months we have been sending official and official-sensitive information to you via something called Egress Switch.

Egress Switch is an encryption service that ensures any sensitive, personal information can be sent to you securely – and which you can respond to securely using a free Egress Switch service.

As you may know, sending emails via GCSx mailboxes is only secure if the email is being sent **between** GCSx (or equivalent) mailboxes and as the only organisations that have such mailboxes are government organisations such as (some) central government departments, police, health, etc., Suffolk County Council decided to use the much safer option of Egress, where official and official-sensitive emails can be sent and received in a secure way.

We do still use GCSx mailboxes when we are communicating directly with the organisations described above. However, for everything else we use Egress Switch, including communications to schools.

It may be that you have not received an encrypted email from us yet and I am also enclosing the Recipient Guidance Notes to enable you to register with the free Egress Service (as described above) when you need to.

I am sure you will agree that the security of our young people's personal, sensitive data is of paramount importance and would appreciate your continued co-operation in assisting us to keep that data safe and secure.

How to access and reply to an Egress Switch Secure Email free of charge

As an Egress Switch Secure Email recipient, you can access encrypted files quickly and easily. You can also communicate securely with paying customers absolutely free of charge – both when you are initiating communication with them and when you are replying to an encrypted email.

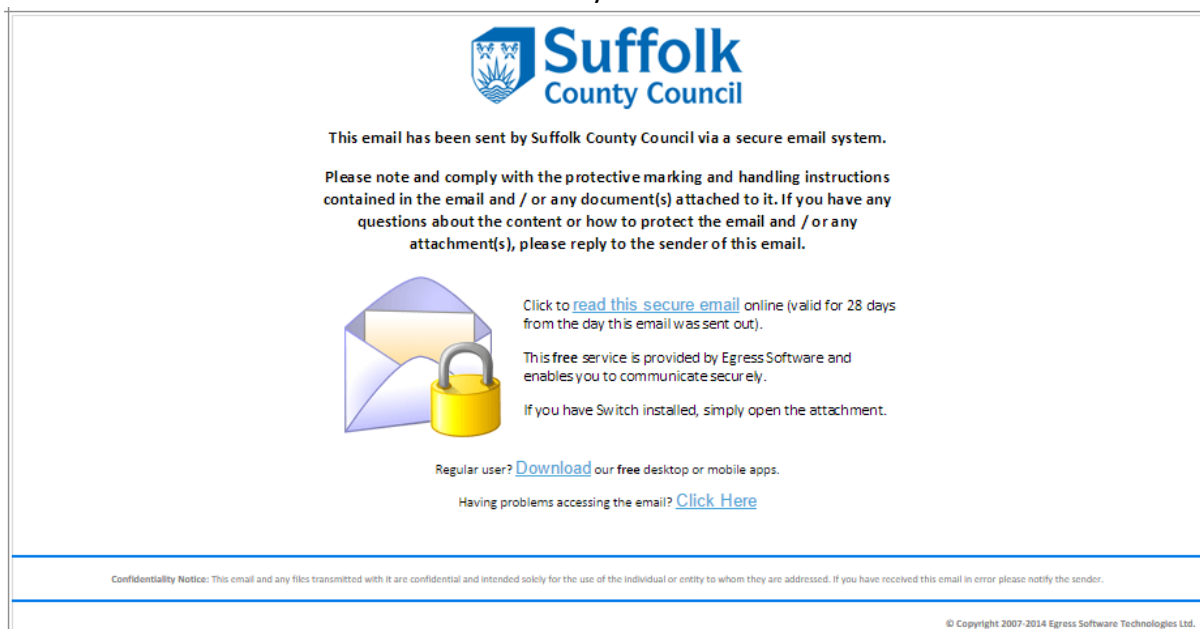
You are not required to download or install any software to read a Switch Secure Email, although desktop and mobile apps can be downloaded free of charge from www.egress.com.

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Opening a Switch Secure Email – New User

As a first-time user, you will need to create an Egress Switch account. This is a one-time process that only takes a few minutes to complete. Please note, if you already have a Switch account you can progress straight to 'Step 2'.

Click on the link within the notification email you received:

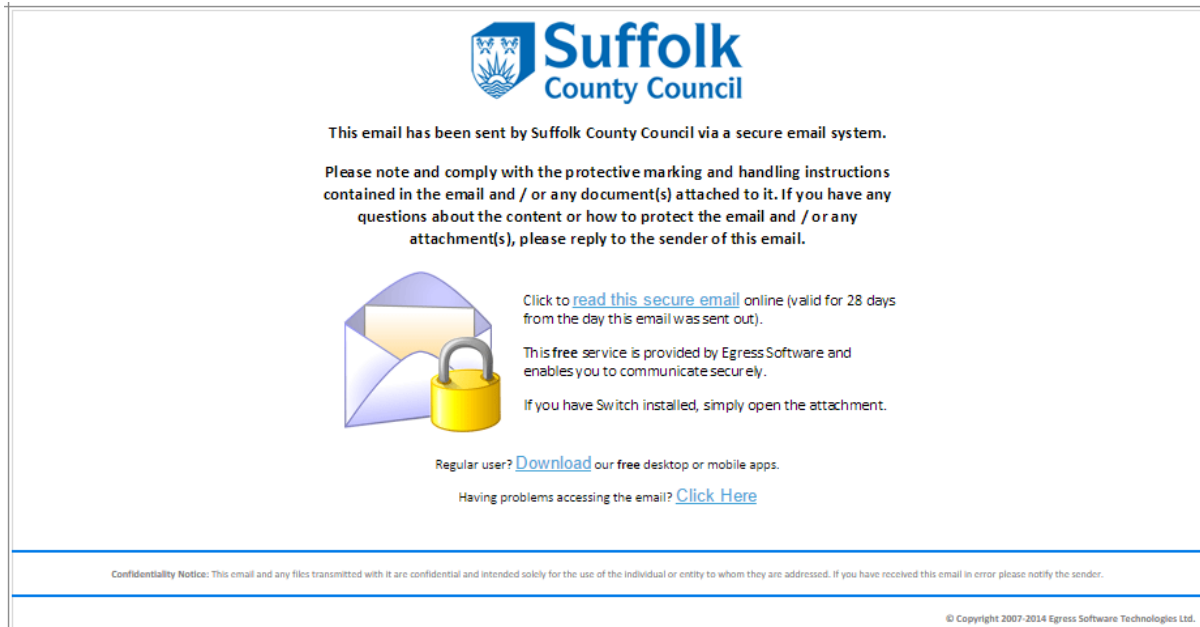

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Reading and replying to a Switch Secure Email

Once registered or signed in, you will be able to access the secure email and any attachments.
