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# Safeguarding children group 2-3 training (e-learning module)

The aim of this e-learning module is to ensure that you have up to date knowledge and skills to deal effectively and promptly with any concerns about individual children. This training course is ratified by the Suffolk Safeguarding Partnership and supports practitioners who are new to role or acts as a 3-year refresher.

The aims of the course are for practitioners to:

- Define and understand what it means to safeguard children and adults and have an awareness of current safeguarding issues.
- Understand who may be at risk and why, identify types of abuse and how they may manifest themselves.
- Understand key changes in legislation, policies, guidance, practice and recommendations from Safeguarding Practice Reviews (SPR), that have been implemented to keep children safe.
- Understand how and who to report to if you have a safeguarding concern, and how that concerns is managed by yourselves and other professionals.

The module should take up to 3 hours to complete.
