The Suffolk and Norfolk SCITT Assessment Only route is designed for instructors with significant experience (at least two years), as an unqualified teacher, and who are eligible to gain QTS without undertaking an initial teacher training programme. Candidates are assessed in one of the following age ranges, 3-7, 5-11, 11-16 or 14-19. The programme runs for a maximum of three months.

Applications for places on the Programme for September 2023 need to be submitted by Wednesday, 31 May 2023.




