VSEND – emerging needs / early intervention

Thinking about current practice – How are children and young people currently identified?n what works well, not so well, could be improved?

Preparation for using VSEND:

Ensuring staff are aware of the agreed setting readiness for your setting;

- Sharing VSEND with parents newsletter , website and casework
- Timetable for training staff on VSEND profiles
- Identifying staff, class to use VSEND

Identifying children and young people – new to the school; not settling, not making expected progress, parental concern, on going behavioural difficulties.
