SENDCOs use **VSEND** radar(s) to provide an analysis of:

The child & young person's needs

The interventions in their Setting Readiness used to close any gaps in each domain

How the child & young person's strengths can be relevant to developing a plan to meet continuing needs

Parent/carers level of home confidence where appropriate







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Collecting evidence

What further approaches in Setting Readiness and resources are required to meet needs and how they will be deployed

Improvements, agreed by child & young person, parent/carers and professionals, to achieve over the next year?

What interventions and approaches have been identified to meet the profile of need, which are not currently available to setting/school?

Is there evidence to support that this child / young person may need special educational provision to be made through an EHC Plan?
