## Two strategies for SACRE work 2023-2024: COMMITTEE B

## **Strategy 1 - Representation**

Committee B members represent the Church of England to SACRE. They also represent SACRE and its work to the Church of England community. The C of E has its own committee because of the historic role of the C of E in establishing and maintaining schools and the differences in RE /CW legislation in these schools.

The Diocesan Schools' Adviser makes a regular report on RE or Collective Worship, and more widely about education in the C of E, but members should contribute too. Please inform the co-chairs who will represent you at each meeting.
