

## Remittance Descriptions

You should receive a remittance advice when you are due a payment from the Early Years and Childcare Service at Suffolk County Council.

Please see below for a list of remittance descriptions you may receive.

Remittance Advice	Description
<b>EEF-EYPP-DEPRIVATION</b>	<b>Early Education Funding (EEF) payments</b> which incorporate the EYPP and Deprivation payments.  Funding statements will be available for all providers to view within the Provider Portal at half term and the end of term showing which children have received EYPP and/or Deprivation.
<b>SEN Inclusion</b>	<b>Inclusion Fund payments.</b> If you need to check which children were applied for, please contact your SENCo in the first instance.
<b>SEN High Needs</b>	<b>High Needs Funding payments.</b> If you need to check which children were applied for, please contact your SENCo in the first instance.
<b>SEN DAF</b>	<b>Disability Access Fund payments.</b>
<b>ADD. Special Grant</b>	<b>Any other payments,</b> including surplus funding and payments for professional development.
